Appropriations Update

On May 14th, members of the PTO Appropriations Committee met with Principal Aiello to discuss ways that the PTO could support and enhance the learning environment of Spring Hill. Based on those discussions, the committee recommends that the general PTO

membership approve the appropriation of \$34,458 for the following purposes:

- \$16,000 for High-Quality Rugs in classrooms where carpet will be removed
- \$15,000 for Instructional Supplies
- \$2,400 for Crescent Shaped Tables In upper-grade classrooms
- \$1,058 for Physical Education Equipment and Games

Your PTO President, Denys King, hereby requests that PTO members vote to appropriate funds for the recommended items by 9:00 pm on Friday, May 31. A non-vote is considered a vote in favor of the recommendations.
